

Cash Back Tips

How do you count cash back?

- Determine the total amount requested. For example, \$400.
- Choose a bill. → \$100
- Then, choose another bill. → \$100
- Add the dollar amount of each bill together. $\$100 + \$100 = \$200$
- Continue to select bills and add them together until you reach the right amount.
You can use any combination of bills to reach the correct dollar amount!

What are “Big Bills”?

There are many different types of bills -- \$1, \$5, \$10, \$20, \$50, \$100, etc. “Big Bills” usually refers to \$50 and \$100 bills or anything larger.

- ✿ Counting cash back with amounts like \$415 and \$276 can be more difficult than amounts such as \$400. Just take your time and add as you go along!
